ROLE SUMMARY

The role of the Cityview Campus Pastor is to oversee the life and direction of the Cityview campus of Grandview Christian Church, as defined by Grandview leadership. This will require a firm grasp of Grandview's beliefs, values, vision, and mission, as well as the ability to communicate and implement those at the Cityview campus.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Be willing to join Grandview as a member, if hired
- Be a growing and committed disciple of Jesus
- Have a seminary degree or equivalent
- Alignment with Stone-Campbell values
- Have two years minimum prior experience in church leadership
- Be ordained and able to produce a certificate of ordination
- Possess strong leadership, organizational, and communication skills
- Possess effective teaching and preaching skills
- Be caring, approachable, and passionate about church ministry
- Be evangelistic in ministry approach
- Be relationship and team oriented, with experience in building effective teams and identifying competent leaders
- Possess a demonstrated commitment to excellence
- Demonstrate a willing submission to executive ministry leadership
- Live a life of integrity, which flows from Gospel transformation

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain the desired Grandview values for the campus
- Communicate and implement the vision for Grandview Christian Church and its campuses, as defined by the leadership team, in cooperation with the elders
- Preparing and preaching sermons on a weekly basis per the intervals, themes, and scriptures determined by the senior minister and "host" worship services at other assigned times
- Lead the ongoing administration of baptism, weddings, funerals, etc. as needed

RESPONSIBILITIES (continued)

- Recruit, train, and equip a ministry team composed of paid staff and volunteers to provide leadership and growth of identified ministry areas, including involvement with hiring, termination, and performance appraisal in cooperation with the Executive Minister
- Proactively seek a personal and church presence in the surrounding community
- Encourage discipleship and growth through the creation and support of small group involvement, in conjunction with the Discipleship Team
- Encourage outreach in word and deed and equip believers to share their faith in these ways
- Assist with the preparation of annual budgeting and proactively maintain accountability for expenditures and alignment with budget objectives
- Participation in weekly staff meetings, monthly elders meetings, and other meetings as necessary
- Shepherd and provide pastoral care for the staff, volunteers, and attenders of Cityview
- Handle additional responsibilities as assigned

A CLARIFYING NOTE

Grandview hopes to fill this position approximately six months before the Cityview campus launches to allow for a transition period before the launch. Duties during this time will focus primarily on building a launch team, preaching at the Buffalo campus, and relationship-building, with other responsibilities as assigned.
