Expectations and Guidelines

Home Away From Home is a program designed to link two specific groups of people through friendship: Johnson City community members and international students at East Tennessee State University. The hope is that international students will find a place of welcome and warmth beyond their classrooms and the ETSU campus, in the homes of locals here in Johnson City. Through friendship, families hope to make international students feel a sense of love and welcome, as if they have a home away from home.

Guidelines

- 1. Students and hosts will sign up on a volunteer basis after reading about the program and turning in a brief application.
- 2. Hosts are signing up to be paired with a student for either 1 or 2 semesters. If the student is staying for longer than 2 semesters, and both the host and student are in agreement, they may continue meeting after the 2 semesters.

Expectations:

- 1. **Meeting your Host/Student.** The host will try to contact their student 1-2 times per month. Students should respond to the host's correspondence in a timely manner (within 3-4 days).
- 2. What Hosts and Students Can Do Together. Hosts are free to invite their students to join them in activities similar (but not limited) to: meals in the home or meals out, trips to local places of attraction, grocery shopping, festivals, activities or events in the community, religious celebrations or gatherings, school plays or sporting activities, holiday gatherings, etc. Students can also feel free to invite their hosts to the campus to show them around, to attend any ETSU activities, performances, outings, etc.
- 3. **Respect.** Hosts and students will show mutual respect for each other's country, home, family, religion and cultural background. You are welcome and encouraged to talk about these topics. When you do so, please have a posture of learning and understanding. Every host involved in this program comes from a Christian background. They may invite their student to join them in American cultural or Christian celebrations. Students can feel free to join them as they wish.
