

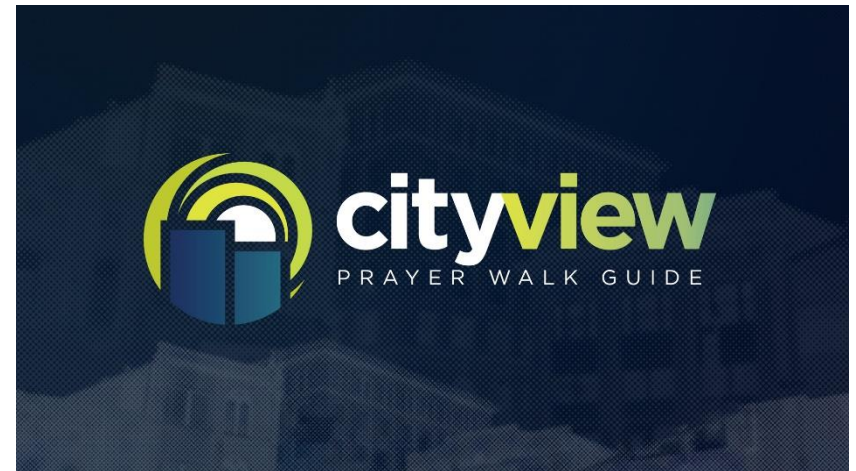
## Prayer Walking Tips

- For our prayer walks, we will have Grandview representatives in cars along each route with a cell phone as a monitor. Each car will have a **RED** flag.
- When walking your route, “walk like you own it.” Confident walking will deter potential difficult encounters.
- We suggest that you not carry a purse or any large sum of money. Maybe have a few dollars in your pocket and if someone does approach you forcefully, give it up!
- For challenging routes, we urge you to walk in groups of 5-7. Safer areas are good for groups of 3.
- Stay together in your group as you walk the path.
- Save your small talk for later. Focus on praying and reading the suggested scriptures aloud.
- Refresh yourself in God during this time. Worship his majesty and faithfulness. Approach God’s throne in reverence.
- Walk and pray aloud (but not loudly!) Read the scriptures. Risk your reputation to build God’s reputation.
- Dream big. Pray hard. Think in terms of 70-year timelines. Pray for God’s kingdom to come.
- Expect to see insights and revelations about downtown.
- Pray for Johnson City officials, safety of the city, and the Opioid epidemic.
- If asked what you are doing, “We’re praying God’s blessing on downtown Johnson City. Are there specific ways we can pray for you or others?”

### PARKING

1. Across Main St. from the Farmer’s Market pavilion.
2. Between Main and Market behind the bus station.
3. Across from the bus station next to 1<sup>st</sup> Presbyterian.
4. Around the Farmer’s Market pavilion.

For safety purposes, we ask that you **return to Founder’s Park NO LATER than 2 pm** and share your insights and return your lanyards

## SCRIPTURES TO PRAY and PONDER

## PRAYER ROUTES

### ROUTE A Safe for Groups of 3

From Founder's Park, walk to West State of Franklin toward South Roan Street and turn RIGHT. Turn RIGHT onto West Walnut Street. Turn RIGHT on Sevier Street. Turn RIGHT onto West State of Franklin. Return to Founder's Park. (1 mile).

### ROUTE B Safe for Groups of 5

From Founder's Park, turn left on Buffalo Street. Turn RIGHT on East Main Street. Turn LEFT on South Roan Street. Turn LEFT on West King (go beside King Commons). Turn LEFT on North Boone Street. Turn LEFT onto South Commerce Street and return to Founder's Park. (1 mile).

### ROUTE C Safe for Groups of 3

From Founder's Park on West State of Franklin, turn RIGHT onto Buffalo Street. Turn RIGHT onto Maple Street. Turn LEFT on Sevier Street (there is no street sign but it is at the first roundabout). Turn LEFT on Pine Street. Turn LEFT on Buffalo Street and return to Founder's Park. (1 mile)

### ROUTE D Safe for Groups of 5-7

From Founder's Park, follow Commerce St along the Farmer's Market pavilion toward Main, cross Main St, turn LEFT on West Market Street and walk past the Bus Station and JC Press. Turn RIGHT on West Watauga (pass Carver Park) and turn RIGHT on Roan Street. Turn RIGHT on Commerce (pass King Commons) and return to Founder's Park. (1.1 mile)

### ROUTE E Safe for Groups of 3

From Founder's Park, turn on South Commerce between Wild Wings and the Park, walking beside the Park. Carefully cross over State of Franklin and the railroad. The street becomes Sevier. Turn LEFT on West Walnut Street. Cross over Buffalo St. Turn LEFT on Spring Street (you will pass Southern Craft BBQ). Carefully cross State of Franklin. Turn LEFT on Main back to Farmer's Market Pavilion and LEFT to Park. (1 mile)
