2. What is your definition of “the least of these?” What has been your experience, if any, with this practice of being with them?

### Buffalo Questions

1. Has someone you loved ever asked you to do something difficult and you didn't hesitate?
2. How many people that you dislike or have difficulties with would you do the same for? Do you have any? Why or not? Why is this different for us?
3. What comes to mind for you when you think of judgement? Do you have a negative or positive reaction to the concept?

### Cityview Questions

1. What does “people at the margins” mean to you? Have you experienced this before?
2. What are ways that we sometimes dismiss people who Jesus describes as the least of these? Why do you think we feel the need to do that? What are expectations we set about their behavior and why?
3. What do you think it means to be a “second floor christian?” How could that work out practically in our lives and relationships? further reading - Why Jesus Crossed the Road by Bruce Main)
