1. What stood out to you about this passage this week? Anything that you might not have noticed before?
2. How do you handle grief? Does your family or friend group have any traditions surrounding grieving a loved one? Is your way of grieving different from the people around you? Do you remember seeing your parents grieve? How much did that impact how you grieve?
3. Why do you think our society tends to avoid dealing with death whenever possible? What are ways we try to do that? What impact does it have on our culture?
4. How did Jesus grieve his friend's death? His cousin's death? How does it make you feel to know God incarnate was moved by human death and grieved it?
5. What do you think it means for us to practice "grieving well?" How can we help one another remember to grieve with hope? What does it look like to grieve as a Kingdom community in a world that often rushes past grief or never truly feels it?
6. How do we know when it's time to turn away from grief?
