- We started the school year at South Side with 17 mentors from Grandview who were matched with 17 fourth graders identified as needing extra support. Each mentor and child meet weekly for one hour and are prayed for regularly by a prayer partner.
- We launched 3 new canopies that met for the duration of the fall focus, including a group specifically for young adults. All the guides were written and edited by our discipleship team, and it was a joy to see this team work together.
- This year's Love JC event included 65-70 Grandview volunteers from serving at 12 different sites around the Johnson City area.

- Need- Continue generating new canopies to help connect those who are looking for community within our congregation.
- Support our JC Serve Partners well and continue connecting Grandviewers to service opportunities in ongoing and need based ways.
- Hold meaningful and lasting conversations this semester in our spring emphasis canopies about loving our neighbor (and how Jesus interacted with different groups of people).

- My third goal concerns discernment about how I will continue into lifelong ministry. This involves asking and wondering about what will be next, but it also includes reflecting on all the things I have learned as a resident at Grandview and how those things prepare me for what is next!
