

Dear Grandview family,

We're approaching our 100th year, and we're taking the opportunity not simply to celebrate where we've been, but to consider how we can faithfully prepare for what comes next.

We're inviting the congregation into a generosity campaign with the goal of \$1.5 million, with three clear purposes;

1. Refresh and reshape the Buffalo Campus (particularly the foyer, kitchen, and the sanctuary).
2. Prepare our Cityview Campus for our next chapter.
3. Invest \$100,000 in our ministry and mission partners.

These aren't investments in buildings for their own sake. They're investments in the spaces where people gather, share, and grow. We're thinking about the child who will grow up here, the neighbor who will come through our doors, the stranger searching for hope, and the people who come along after us.

For nearly 100 years, people before us have made room for us. They gave, served, prayed, and shaped spaces that became places where we encountered Jesus and one another. They created spaces where we celebrated baptisms and weddings and new births. They created spaces where we deepened our understanding of the faith and where we worshiped. They created spaces where we grieved loved ones and said goodbye.

We are all beneficiaries of their faithfulness.

Now it's our turn.

We hope each of us will take time to pray, learn more about the initiative, consider what generosity might look like for our households, and listen for how God is calling us to participate.

The Generosity Campaign isn't something we're asking a few people to accomplish on behalf of Grandview. Every generation has a part to play, and we hope everyone who calls Grandview home, be it our Buffalo Campus, our Cityview Campus, or our friends around the world, will find a way to participate.

I am deeply grateful for the people who have faithfully supported Grandview to this point, and I am grateful that we get to be a part of what comes next. I believe God has given us an important opportunity to steward what we've received and make room for people we have not yet met.

Across Grandview, we see spaces that are outgrown, outdated, or **simply not designed for the ways ministry happens today.**

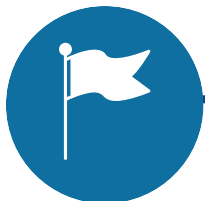
Together, we're investing in spaces that reflect the life within Grandview today and support the ministry God is already doing among us.
